Letter Carriers' Annual Food Drive Collects 70 Million Pounds of Food for the Hungry

In a highly successful nationwide food drive, the National Association of Letter Carriers collected more than 70.5 million pounds of food on Saturday, May 12, at a time when hunger is a major problem. The NALC's annual one-day drive, the largest in the nation, is held on the second Saturday in May in 10,000 cities and towns in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands and Guam. This was the 20th annual NALC Food Drive to stamp out hunger.

Rio Grande District employees joined carriers around the country to bring donated food from their routes on Saturday, May 12, to local food banks, pantries or shelters. Assisting 1,600 local NALC branches were rural letter carriers and other postal employees, plus members of other unions and civic volunteers.

"These results will enable the food pantries that we supply across the country to help feed the 50 million Americans, one-third of them children, who live in families that lack sufficient food," NALC President Fredric Rolando said.
